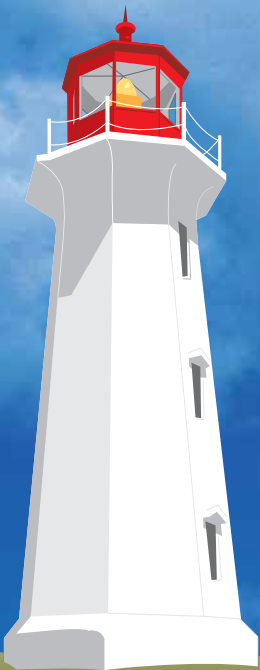

Wednesday, June 17 (0730 - 1700) – Halifax Citadel



This is the first day of the event. Meet the KidScenes team and get to know each other with some games and crafts in the early morning. Gather a bag lunch from the hotel, and head to the Halifax Citadel for a tour and a chance to explore the area. There will be time for lunch and for outside games, then children will return to the hotel. (**Off-site on Wednesday will be available for all children. The youngest will enjoy a walk in the outdoors, and be able to come back to the hotel with their caregiver at any time.**)

Thursday, June 18 (0700 – 1730) – Discovery Centre



Welcome back! The theme for the day will be science and discovery! Once all the children have arrived, we will head off to the Discovery Centre - Nova Scotia's Hands-On Science Centre, for the morning. Children will return to the hotel for lunch, and then will spend the afternoon swimming and doing their own science experiments. (**Off-site on Thursday will be for all children 3 years and older.**)

Friday, June 19 (0730 – 1800) – Hatfield Farm



This will be a day of adventure! Once everyone has arrived, the group will board the bus and head to Hatfield Farm. The children will enjoy a wagon ride, the "rubber rodeo", lunch, mini-golf and a pony ride. Upon returning to the hotel, there will be crafts and games for all children. (**Off-site on Friday will be for school age children.**)

Saturday, June 20 (0730 – 1730) - Maritime Museum and Pier 21



Join us for a day to explore the ocean and the history of the harbour! Children will visit the Maritime museum and Pier 21. Once everyone arrives, we will get our picnic lunch from the hotel and head to the Maritime museum. After the tour and scavenger hunt there, we'll have lunch and head to Pier 21 where all children will get to find out what it would have been like to be an immigrant arriving in Canada. The trip to Pier 21 will end with a workshop where all children will be able to make an Inukshuk. Upon returning to the hotel there will be quiet games, crafts and activities for the children.

Sunday, June 21 (0730 – 1200)

Our last day together will be a quiet one. We'll make some memory books, play some favorite games, and enjoy our last day together either outside, in the pool or in the KidScenes room.

Note

Young children **not going off-site** will have a great space set up with toys, games, and enthusiastic caregivers. Caregivers will take children outside as there is lots of green space within close walking distance to the hotel. Young children will be provided with quiet time for naps and time for play during their week with KidScenes staff.
