These include management of low grade SIL, HPV testing, liquid based cytology, vulvar lesions, and colposcopic interpretation of abnormal vessel patterns.

We are very pleased this year to have Dr. John W. Sellors joins us for our meeting. The titles of his talks are posed as questions: "Can we learn anything from screening and treatment R&D in the developing world?" and "HPV vaccination - Is this a prevention panacea?" We look forward to hearing from John on these topics.

During the program, don't hesitate to ask questions of the speakers and engage in the debates that may ensue. We would be very grateful if you could fill out the evaluation forms at the end of the day.

During the past year, the Society has been moving forward on a number of fronts. Our website www.colposcopycanada.org continues to evolve. Many of our members have been involved with organizing and participating in SOGC regional meetings giving talks on colposcopy, preinvasive and lower genital tract benign disease.

A major accomplishment has been the completion of the update of the Colposcopy Training Guidelines as endorsed by the SOGC/SCC/GOC Guidelines Committee and The Association of Professors of Obstetrics and Gynaecology of Canada (APOG). The Guidelines were published in the April issue of the Journal of the SOGC. Dr. Susan McFaul, SCC Secretary-Treasurer, took the lead on the project and is to be congratulated on seeing this through to completion. This represents a major step forward towards maintaining and continually improving the quality of colposcopy services across Canada.

Probably the biggest issue to come forward this year is the likelihood that HPV Vaccination will be available in Canada before the end of 2006. SCC has been actively involved with SOGC and other societies and agencies to map out a rational implementation of the vaccine in Canada. This is no easy task. Implementation will need tremendous cooperation between gynecologists, pediatricians, family doctors, infectious disease experts, STI clinics, dermatologists, vaccinologists, immunologists, public health, schools, and parents. Successful knowledge transfer about all aspects of HPV and the vaccine is critical. The impact of a successful implementation will be profound. Please join us during the afternoon session today when Dr. Vyta Senikas, Associate Executive VP and CPD Division Director for the SOGC, will introduce "Linking HPV to the Practice of Immunization" an interactive program intended to provide healthcare professionals with the knowledge and skills to increase their ability to prevent, diagnose and treat HPV and HPV related diseases.

International Invited Guest Speaker

John W. Sellors, MD

John W. Sellors is a senior medical advisor for the Reproductive Health Strategic Program at PATH (Program for Appropriate Technology in Health). His technical areas of expertise include: applied research, capacity building, epidemiology, health services research, health technology assessment, operations research, quality assurance, reproductive health, STD programs, supervision, and training. He has over 25 years of primary care medicine and extensive community-based health services and epidemiological research experience in Canada and many developing countries. He is an author on approximately 200 publications and is an associate editor of the Journal of Evidence-based Medicine and the American College of Physicians Journal Club. He currently holds the appointments of visiting professor at the University of Washington and clinical professor at McMaster University. At PATH, he is the leader of the START project and provides strategic and technical leadership for the Alliance for Cervical Cancer Prevention (ACCP) project and for the HPV Vaccine project. He became co-chair of the Human Subjects Protection Committee at PATH in 2004.

Guest Speakers

Terry Colgan, MD

Dr. Colgan is an anatomical pathologist, and practicing gynecological pathologist. Currently, he is Head of the Section of Gynecological Pathology at the Mount Sinai Hospital, Associate Staff at the University Health Network, and a Professor in the Departments of Laboratory Medicine and Pathobiology and Obstetrics & Gynecology at the University of Toronto. He is actively involved in both teaching and research in gynecological pathology, and is an editor of the International Journal of Gynecological Pathology, Cancer (Cytopathology), Acta Cytologica, Archives of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine, and Journal of Lower Genital Tract Disease. He is a past Chairman of the Canadian Society of Cytology, the Society of Canadian Colposcopists, and the American Society of Cytopathology's Committee on Centers of Excellence. He is a member of the College of American Pathologist's Cytopathology Resource Committee. His primary research interest is preventive oncology, including the screening and diagnosis of genital tract neoplasia, new technologies in cervical screening, hereditary cancer, and the application of proteomics to endometrial disease. Along with Drs. Michael Siu and Alex Romaschin, and with the support of the National Cancer Institute of Canada and Canadian Institutes of Health Research, he has developed a biomarker discovery program using tissue proteomics. Tom Ehlen, MD

Dr. Ehlen graduated from medical school in Mainz, Germany. After residencies in General Surgery and Obstetrics and Gynaecology in Frankfurt, Germany and Vancouver, BC, he did a Fellowship in Gynaecologic Oncology in Los Angeles and in Toronto. Since 1991, Dr. Ehlen has been working at Vancouver General Hospital and the British Columbia Cancer Agency. He is an Assistant Professor at UBC and since 2003 the Medical Director for Surgical Services at Vancouver General Hospital and UBC Hospital. Dr. Ehlen is the Medical Director of the BC Provincial Colposcopy Program.

Marie-Claude Renaud, MD

Dr. Marie-Claude Renaud is a gynecologic oncologist at the CHUQ – L'Hôtel-Dieu de Québec in Québec City. She is presently an associate teacher at Laval University. Dr. Renaud did her fellowship training in Montréal. She is experienced in advanced laparoscopic surgery and in vaginal radical surgery and is also an active colposcopist.

Dr. Renaud is a Board Member of the Society of Canadian Colposcopists.

Leslie Sadownik, MD

Dr. Leslie Sadownik is currently an Assistant Professor in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of British Columbia. She completed a master's degree in Adult Education at UBC and is now Director of the Faculty of Medicine Faculty Development Program. Her Clinical practice focuses on lower genital tract disease including chronic vulvar pain. She is also an educational consultant for the BCCA Provincial Colposcopy Program.

Vyta Senikas, MD

Dr. Vyta Senikas graduated from McGill University in 1970 with an Honours B.Sc. in Biochemistry and later pursued doctoral studies in medicine and a masters of surgery (MDCM) at McGill University from 1970 to 1974. Dr. Senikas completed her internship and residency in obstetrics/gynaecology at McGill University from 1975 to 1980. She later received a research grant in the field of perinatology from the Hôpital Sainte-Justine (Université de Montréal) in 1979-80. Dr. Senikas was President of the McGill Association of Interns and Residents from 1977-79, President of the Fédération des internes et résidents du Québec from 1979 to 1980, Assistant Professor at McGill University from 1982 to 1985 and Associate Professor since 1985. She has been actively in practice at the Royal Victoria and Queen Elizabeth hospitals since 1980. Dr. Senikas' many activities include serving as President of the general overview of obstetrics-gynaecology in 1991-92, Director of Obstetrics at the Royal Victoria Hospital from 1991 to 1994, Medical Director at the birthing centre of the Royal Victoria Hospital from 1992 to 1994, and Director of the restructuring project for the new obstetrical centre. Dr. Senikas has worked as an administrator since 1987. In addition to being a member of the Society of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists of Canada, she was a member of the Association des obstétriciens et gynécologues du Québec (AOGQ) Board of Directors from 1987 to 2000.

She served on the executive of the AOGQ from 1991 until 1999 and was President of the Association des obstétriciens et gynécologues du Québec (AOGQ) for the years 1997-1998. Dr. Senikas represented the AOGQ in dealings with the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG) from 1989-2001. She has also served the ACOG as an External Peer Reviewer in the field of medical training since 1992. She was seconded by the AOGQ to the Federation of Medical Specialists of Quebec in 1994, led the open discussion forum at the 1994 International Federation of Gynaecologists and Obstetricians in Montreal; chaired the AOGQ rate-setting committee in 1995; and served as delegated chair of the AOGQ.

Since 1997, Dr. Senikas sits as a counsellor for the Canadian Medical Protective Association and has been a member of its executive since 2001.

Dr. Senikas has been a member of SOGC since 1979, has sat on Council, various committees including post Vice-President. She is currently the Associate Executive Vice-President of SOGC in charge of Continuing Professional Development.

Dr. Wright is Professor Emeritus, Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, The Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry, London, Ontario, Canada. He received his medical degree from the same university and did his Obstetrics & Gynaecology training at the State University of New York at Buffalo, New York and his oncology training at the Roswell Park Memorial Cancer Institute and the Gynaecological Cancer Center, New Castle-Upon-Tyne, England. He has published in the peer reviewed literature, been editor or coeditor of scientific textbooks and has been an invited lecturer in over 30 different countries, some of them many times. He has received many scientific awards both nationally and internationally. 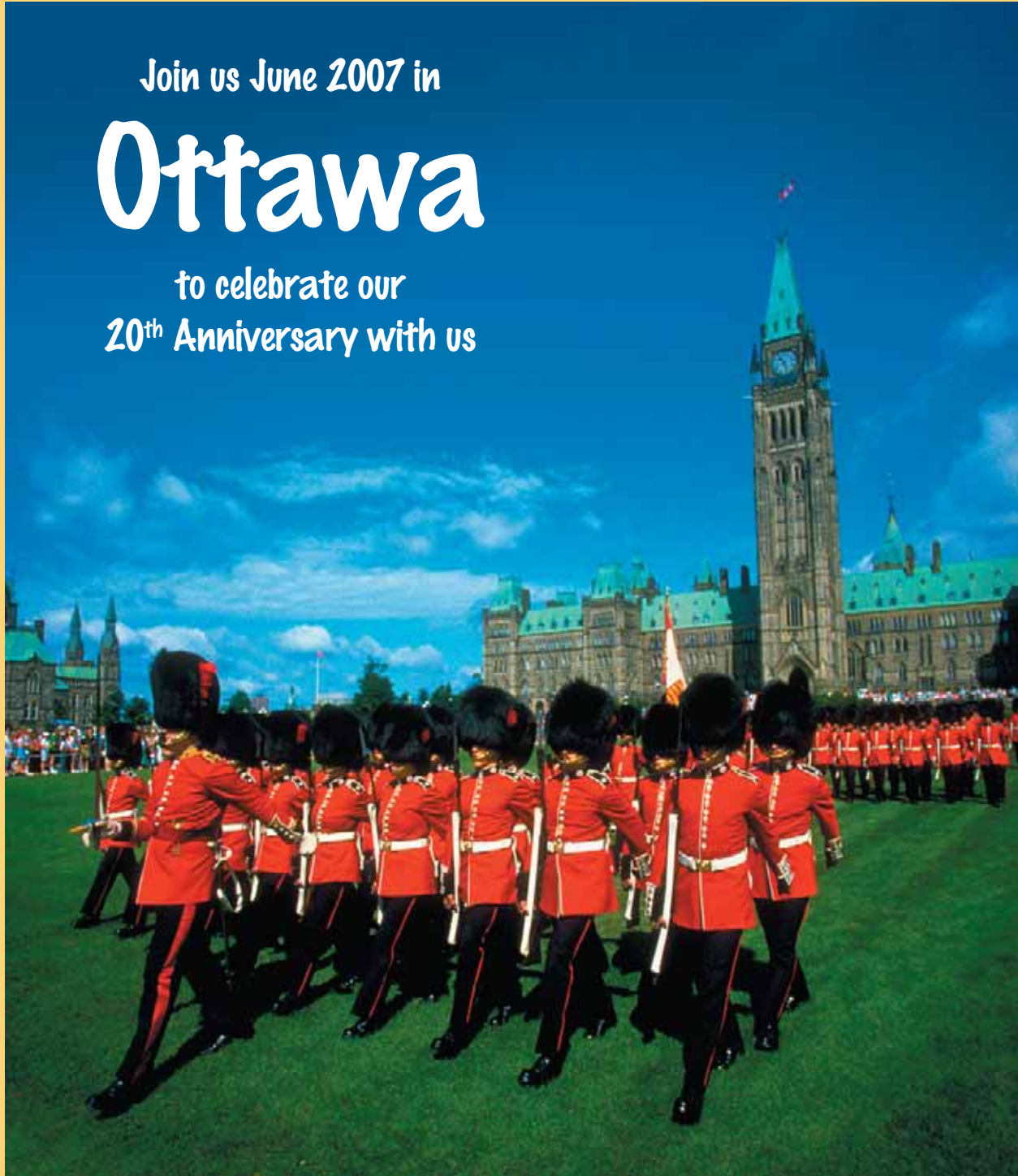
