We are seeking a general Obstetrician and Gynecologist to join our team with the ability to work in a high volume and clinically demanding environment. Background training or intent to complete training in a 6-month fellowship in vulvar health and colposcopy is highly desirable.

Fellowship education in the areas of Maternal Fetal Medicine and Advanced Gynaecologic Surgery and Health Quality Improvement is part of the academic mission of NYGH. The successful applicant will be expected to join at the rank of assistant professor or higher.

Successful applicants must be licensed for independent practice with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, and hold specialist certification in Obstetrics and Gynaecology with the Royal College of Physician and Surgeons of Canada. They must hold appropriate malpractice insurance with the Canadian Medical Protective Association.

The successful candidate will join and contribute to a program of excellence in obstetrics and gynecology as part of our family centred program. The additional skills and training the candidate brings will further the academic mandate of the department.
