WLMH has an exciting opportunity for an **Obstetrician/Gynecologist locum position** to work along-side a busy established Obstetrician/Gynecologists in providing care for low-risk pregnancies, gynecological care and surgery in our newly updated surgical department. The Obstetrician/Gynecologists, also would provide consultant support for a large group of family physicians, who provide primary care to the community as well as family physicians who do obstetrics and Midwives.

WLMH recently completed an 18 month infrastructure project, including updating the operating rooms, and continues to reintroduce obstetrical and surgical services as well as expanded day surgery procedures post renovation and redirection of services related to COVID-19. WLMH is in the process of redevelopment, with the new facility slated to open in 2025.
