



**One Year Locum Opportunity

The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Dalhousie University, has a locum opportunity for a General Obstetrician Gynaecologist. This position is available until September 5, 2022.

This is a full-time locum opportunity, but an FTE less than 1.0 would be considered. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to work in an academic setting, providing care to women in the Maritime region. The physician will be expected to provide ambulatory and surgical care for women; and participate in both the obstetrics and gynaecology call rotas.

Candidates should possess an FRCSC or equivalent certification and have strong surgical skills. The department will give preference to applicants with experience and expertise in gynaecologic surgery. Candidates must demonstrate the ability to collaborate effectively with their peers.

This position is part of a group practice, located at the IWK Health Centre in Halifax, Nova Scotia, with a community clinic in Dartmouth. Halifax is a coastal city on the eastern seaboard of Canada. In addition to its beautiful oceanfront views, the city offers its residents the best qualities of both a smaller city (friendly citizens, safe neighbourhoods), and being a cultural hub of the Maritimes it also offers the amenities usually reserved for larger centers (multiple Universities, a vibrant arts scene and great dining options).
