

Full-Time Obstetrician/Gynecologist

Quinte Health Care is seeking a full time Obstetrician/Gynecologist to join collegial group in highly desirable community

Quinte Health Care is expanding the department to seven full-time Obstetricians/Gynecologists who provide specialized consultative, urgent, and emergency care to women across the care continuum. The successful candidate will provide 24 hour on-call coverage of one-in-seven for both obstetric and gynecologic care, including consults and referrals for in-patients and out-patient care from the Emergency Departments, family physicians, other specialty services, and midwives. They will also have equal share of OR allocation for gynecologic surgeries, and minor surgery clinic for colposcopy (if desired) amongst the department. Interest in urogynecology is an asset, but not required.

The Quinte area is in south-eastern Ontario. The Obstetrics and Gynecology service is offered at our Belleville General Hospital location. In 2021, Maclean's ranked Belleville as the fourth best place in Canada to live! QHC's three other hospitals are located in Picton, Quinte West (includes Trenton and Brighton), and Bancroft. The area includes some of the most diverse and beautiful countryside in Ontario. From the lakes of Bancroft down to the wine country, picturesque towns, and Sandbanks beach of Prince Edward County, and through the more urban Belleville/Quinte West/Brighton corridor alongside Lake Ontario, almost every lifestyle interest can be found within the communities served by QHC. The region offers low cost of living, excellent amenities, excellent schools as well as quality local theatre, shopping and restaurants. Belleville and Quinte West are located along the highway 401 corridor, and Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal, and Kingston are all easy driving distance.

Births at Quinte Health Care each year average around 1,500. Our Maternal Child unit at QHC Belleville General Hospital has a 17 bed obstetrical unit, an 8 bed Level 2A special care nursery for high risk newborns (accepting neonates 34 weeks and up), two operating rooms for Cesarean sections, and a shared obstetrical assessment – triage clinic. We work closely with skilled colleagues in pediatrics, anesthesia and radiology.

Obstetrician/Gynecologists have the opportunity to educate and mentor residents from Queen's University, with members usually holding a Queen's University appointment.



Applicants must hold Canadian Citizenship and must be certified or eligible for certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be eligible for a full independent medical license with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO).

Ample opportunities exist for candidates who are experienced and interested in leadership and administrative roles.

Payment is fee-for-service with call stipend, and remuneration for resident supervision through Queen's University.

Quinte Health Care has 1,800 staff members and 320 medical staff who provide a wide range of high quality health care services to a region of 160,000 residents.
